Vision of the four living creatures.

- · Concerns the gospel preached in all the world.
- Participate in the destruction of old Jerusalem. Ezekiel 10:7.

Salvation of the Jewish Remnant.

Ezekiel 5:3; 6:8-10; 7:16; 9:4-6; 11:14-21; 13:23; 14:11; 14:22-23; 16:53; 20:33-44; 28:25-26; 34:11-16; 36:21-35; 37:23; 39:25-29.

Destruction of old Jerusalem.

- Chapters 4 through 24. See Eze 33:21; 40:1.
- "Jerusalem" mentioned 26 times.
- New Jerusalem replaces the Old Jerusalem.

Destruction of the Gentile Nations.

Chapters 25-32 and 38 and 39.

Description of the Temple and New Jerusalem.

- Chapters 39 through 48.
- Waters flow out from the house. Ezekiel 47:1-11.
- "City" is used 17 times in Chapters 40-48.
- 12 gates with names of 12 tribes. Ezekiel 48:31-34.
- City named, "The Lord is there". Ezekiel 48:35.
- "City is in Ezekiel 47 times.
- Ezekiel is about two cities: one destroyed; one arrives from heaven.

Revelation.

Vision of the four beasts.

- The 4 beasts are before the throne of God praising Him. Rev 4:6-11.
- Participate in the destruction of old Jerusalem. Revelation 6:1; 15:7.

Salvation of the Jewish Remnant.

Revelation 7:1-8.

Destruction of old Jerusalem.

- Chapters 6-18. See Rev 11:2; 11:8; 14:20.
- "City" is mentioned 28 times in Revelation.
- New Jerusalem replaces Old Jerusalem.

Destruction of the Gentile Nations.

• Rev 17:12-14; 19: Rev 19:11-20; Rev 20:7-9.

Description of the New Jerusalem.

- Chapters 21 and 22:1-7.
- River of water of life is there. Revelation 22:1-2.
- "City" is used 10 times in the description of New Jerusalem.
- 12 gates with names of 12 tribes. Revelation 21:12-14.
- "Tabernacle of God is with men", Rev 21:3. The throne of God is there, Revelation 22:1.
- Called the New Jerusalem. Revelation 3:12; 21:2.
- Revelation is about two cities: one is destroyed, the other comes down to the earth from heaven.
